Content (Syllabus outline)

Basic notions of criminal procedure law and criminal procedure: concept and role of criminal procedure law in legal system of a state, types of criminal procedures, bodies that take part in criminal procedure, sources and basic principles of criminal procedure law. Subjects in criminal procedure: public prosecutor, victim as prosecutor, private prosecutor, the defendant, police, attorneyship, forensic experts, witnesses, other subject in procedure. Objects in criminal procedure: pecuniary claim, preliminary questions, costs of criminal procedure. Procedural acts in criminal procedure: conduct of criminal procedure, decision-making, evidence adduction, evidence exclusion, measures of procedural constraint in criminal procedure giving emphasis to detention and measures for evidence assurance. Pretrial procedure. Regular criminal procedure: investigation, accusation, trial, ordinary legal remedies. Abbreviated criminal procedure: particularities in comparison with regular procedure, procedure for punishment order. Extraordinary legal remedies: claim for protection of legality, renewal of procedure, claim for extraordinary reduction of penalty. Criminal procedure against juveniles. Special criminal procedures.
