Competition policy and economics. The international dimension of European competition law. Collusion: notion of undertaking, agreement, decisions, concerted practice, object and effect of restricting competition, effect on trade between Member States. Exemptions from collusion: basic conditions and block exemptions. Abuse of dominant position: single and collective dominance, basic types of abuse. Concentrations: jurisdictional rules, substantive rules and procedural rules. Enforcement of European competition law and procedures. Public undertakings related to restrictions of competition. State aids related to restrictions of competition.
