Questions

Trib Prato (EOPP 2016)- DISTANCE BETWEEN EOPP AND NATIONAL CIVIL PROCEDURE

“The claimant served the statement of claim without complying with the time limit set by the court following the filing of the opposition to the European order for payment pursuant to Article 17 of Regulation (EC) No 1896/2006. No legislation allows the courts to set a mandatory time limit for the party seeking a payment order for supplementing the statement of claim in response to an opposition by the party on which the European order for payment was served. The defendant may, at most, assert the failure to comply with Article 163-bis of the Italian Civil Procedure Code and ask that the hearing be deferred. So the objection seeking the annulment of the proceedings pursuant to Article 307(3) of the Italian Civil Procedure Code is undounded»

G.d.P. Vicenza (ESCP 2018)- LINGUISTIC PROBLEMS AND LEGAL DIVERSITY:

«Model A filled up in English: the G.d.P. asked for the Italian translation in 30 days. The Claimant didn't allege it and the claim was rejected for this reason».

G.d.P. Aosta (ESCP 2018):DELAYED JUSTICE IN ITALY

«Problems of servings a Judgment issued in 2016: after unsuccessful attempts with UNEP and the postal service, it was only succeeded through the Consulate»


